Workshop Synopsis:

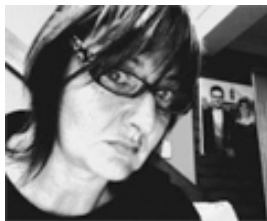
This workshop is for students who want to write beautifully with a calligraphy pen? Activities will provide a finished work artwork for inclusion in visual arts portfolios?

- learn how to adapt these in different styles of writing
- explore the art of the illuminated letter and manuscript
- design and hand letter a single section handmade artist book
