Increase the cohort GPA for Groups 1, 4 & 5 from Year 11 Semester 2 to Year 12 Final IB Diploma grades through

1. increasing Stretch i.e. percentage of 6/7's or 5/6's
2. increasing Lift i.e. percentage of students achieving 4 or better

Our initiatives include

LIFT AND STRETCH – BOOST Program

- Regularly monitor and respond to student performance data.
- Provide small group LIFT tutorial support to cover gaps in content knowledge, improve subject specific skills and focus on exam preparation and strategies. These would be teacher directed 1 hour weekly sessions.
- Provide small group STRETCH tutorial support for students either side of the 5/6 grade boundary to increase the % of students achieving a 6 and above, by focusing on applying higher order analytical skills to solve complex or novel problems. These would be teacher directed 1 hour weekly sessions.
- Provide small group support to students at risk in Groups 1, 4 and 5.
- Provide one-on-one tutoring to identified Year 11 & 12 Higher Level or Standard Level students to support their learning.


Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employment of tutors to provide 1-1 tutoring for students with literacy needs. Provide 1-1 literacy support for 10 students once per week for 1 hour for 8 weeks per term for 2 terms.
- Employment of challenge tutors to provide 1-1 support for identified students who have the potential to reach the stretch benchmark of a grade 6 or 7 in their subject. Provide 1-1 challenge/extension support to 10 students once per week for 1 hour for 8 weeks per term for 2 terms.
- Provide 1-1 exam support during SWOTVAC for identified "at risk" and borderline stretch students across a range of subjects.
