NOTES:

- Students studying the IB Diploma must study six subjects. During the IB
 Diploma Programme three (3) subjects must be studied at Standard Level
 and three (3) subjects must be studied at Higher Level. The six subjects
 do not include TOK, CAS and EE and must be chosen from the six subject
 areas outlined above.
- Students study the subject *Science* in Year 10 to prepare them for any of the Sciences in the Diploma Programme.
- Students study the subject Maths in Year 10 to prepare them for any of the Mathematics subjects.
- Students are able to study two subjects from either the Sciences, Language Acquisition or Individuals and Societies instead of an Arts subject.

- Students are able to study two subjects from The Arts **instead of a** Science subject. (See note 1.)
- Students must select Environmental Systems and Societies (ESS) in Individuals and Societies as their transdisciplinary Science subject if studying two subjects from The Arts.
- Students who wish to study Korean need a proficiency level to interact with a degree of fluency on a wide range of subjects. Korean cannot be studied at Ab intio level.

Whilst we do our best to accommodate student and family decisions, subjects offered are dependent upon student numbers, teacher availability, resourcing and International Baccalaureate requirements. In the event a subject cannot run, students will be required to select another subject.
