



2016 ASPIRE Nomination

ACADEMIC STUDENT OF THE YEAR

AWARD INTENT:

To recognise the highest performing academic student in Year 12

AWARD CRITERIA:

A student will be eligible for this award if:

1. They will **complete Year 12 in 2016**.
2. They are **eligible for the International Baccalaureate (IB) diploma**.
3. They **receive the highest predicted IB score at the time of submission of predicted grades**.
4. If they achieve a predicted grade of 45 they will automatically receive the award and there will be no further discrimination between students with a 45.

5. If two or more students are equal in their predicted grade, and it is less than 45, the following will be used to determine the recipient (in this order):
 - a. Students will be compared head to head on the predicted grades in the Group 1-6 subjects. Example: number of 7's, 6's. HL and SL subjects will not be differentiated.
 - b. Students will be compared head to head in common subjects discriminating to raw predicted marks that were used in the arrival of predicted grades.
 - c. Students will be compared head to head on A to E results for the components of the inner core.
