- Students studying the IB Diploma must study 6 subjects - a minimum of 3 at higher level and a maximum of 4 at higher level. The 6 subjects do not include TOK, CAS and EE and must be chosen from the 6 groupings outlined above.
 - QAHS students may make a second selection from Group 3 or 4, instead of the subjects listed for Group 6. Societies in Group 3 OR take one subject from Group 6 and one from Group 4.
 - QASMT student may make a second selection from Group 4 instead of the subjects listed for Group 6.
 - QACI students may take two subjects from Group 6, but must take Environmental Systems and Societies in Group 3 OR take one subject from Group 6 and one from Group 4.
- ◆ Subject can be studied independently - application process applies.
* SL in Anticipated mode only - this means the subject is fast tracked, students take IB exams at the end of Year 11.
