

NOTES:

- Students studying the IB Diploma must study six subjects a minimum of three at higher level (maximum of four). The six subjects do not include TOK, CAS and EE and must be chosen from the six groupings outlined above.
- Students are able to study two subjects from Sciences instead of an Arts subject.
- Students study the subject *Science* in Year 10 to prepare them for any of the Sciences in the Diploma Programme.
- Students study the subject Maths in Year 10 to prepare them for any of the Mathematics subjects.
- Students are able to study two subjects from The Arts instead of a Science subject. Students must select Environmental Systems and Societies (ESS) in Individuals and Societies as their transdisciplinary Science subject.
- Students studying SL Music have the choice to study SL Solo Performance or SL Music Composition.
- Students who wish to study Korean need a proficiency level to interact with a degree of fluency on a wide range of subjects. Korean cannot be studied at Ab intio level.
